3-D Figurines

The crafts project for this title consists of three 3-dimensional figurines assembled from paper cutouts. You have two options:

- 1) Use the B&W masters and color the figurines before cutting them out;
- 2) Use the already colored figurine masters.

Figurine parts

Anamík: body, head, arms, snowshoes

Tlalí: body, head, arms, snowshoes

Chief: body, head, arms

Coloring the B&W masters

- 1) On the computer

You can import the B&W masters into your favorite drawing program and color the cutouts there.


- 2) Manually






Print out the masters as B&W on a heavier paper. Color manually with pencils, watercolor, or crayons.

Assembly of the Figurines




Once you have colored the figurine parts, cut them out from the master pages. Don't cut off the glue tabs.




- a) Glue together the head pieces, applying the glue to the glue tabs.
- b) Glue together the body cones. Again, use the glue tabs.
- c) Attach the arms and the snowshoes to the body cones.
- d) Attach the heads.





